GOAL 1: Hiring Staff to develop our Worship Ministries. *We are currently in the beginning phase of this search. We have received 4 resumes and our search committee will have our first meeting soon!*

GOAL 2: Develop a Ministry Team to help plan and implement church vision. Launching in Spring. *Stay tuned on this — you will be hearing about it in April. GOAL 5: Further develop Elder Team oversight of church ministries by June of 2018. *I am so grateful for our Elder Team — they are very willing to serve! We will explore this a bit more in-depth as a team in April on our first Elders & Wives Retreat.*

GOAL 6: A deeper prayer life – not necessarily more – but deeper for me personally. *I am longing more and more for quality time with God. I truly desire to be after His heart.*
